Attachment to Complaint against Montana Women Vote.

Montana Women Vote is in violation of Mont. Code Ann. § 13-37-225 for failing to include the required "paid for by" disclaimer on its internet publications regarding its involvement in the I-164 400% Interest is Too High Campaign. Please see the attached printouts of Montana Women Vote's webpages containing election material absent the statutorily required disclosure. Please note the first attachment is dated March 18, 2010, and the second attachment is dated May 5, 2010. The Facebook postings by Montana Women Vote urge "friends" to sign the I-164 petition or to volunteer to gather signatures for I-164, which clearly qualifies as election materials because of its intention to influence the outcome of an election. Each day that these election materials have been available on the internet, advocating support of the ballot issue constitutes a separate violation of Montana's Elections and Campaign Practices chapter. Montana Women Vote may claim that its coverage constitutes an exception to the statutory definition of "contribution"; however, that claim is misplaced because the bona fide news story exception to the definition of "contribution" requires that the story be "distributed through the facilities of any broadcasting station, newspaper, magazine, or other periodical publication of general circulation." Mont. Code Ann. § 13-1-101(7)(b)(ii). Certainly, this website is not a newspaper, magazine or periodical of general circulation.

The attached flyer urging individuals to "help protect other Montana families from the payday lending trap" is also a clear violation of Mont. Code Ann. § 13-37-225. It does not contain the required disclosure, but qualifies as election material which requires such disclosure. The timing of the flyer clearing coincides with the collection of petition signatures for I-164 and has the intended effect of advertising for the initiative. All expenses associated with the creation and distribution of each flyer produced are required to be reported.

As evidenced by press coverage and the length of time that the proponents have been publicly promoting this ballot issue, complainant is under the belief and therefore alleges that if investigation of Montana Women Vote took place, one would find unreported resources have been utilized in support of the ballot issue. The dates on the attached webpage printouts show that Montana Women Vote is also in violation of Mont. Code Ann. §§ 13-37-229; 13-37-230 and ARM 44.10.411, which require reporting of all contributions to a ballot issue and all expenditures made on behalf of a ballot issue. Further, in-kind expenditures must be reported on the day that the expenditure is made, and the filed C-4 reports do not comply with this timing requirement. ARM 44.10.323. See generally In the Matter of the Complaint Against the Montana Chamber of Commerce Regarding Its Activities In Opposition to I-121 And I-125, decided June 2000, regarding failure to timely report in-kind contributions and expenditures.

Montana Women Vote filed its C-2 Statement of Organization on April 27, 2010. C-2's are required by Mont. Code Ann. § 13-37-201 to be filed within 5 days of making "an expenditure or authoriz[ing] another person to make an expenditure on its behalf, whichever occurs first." The date on the website acknowledging support of the ballot issue is March 18, 2010, and the date on the first C-4 acknowledges working on the ballot issue as far back as February 1, 2010. By its own admission in its C-4 report, the date Montana Women Vote filed its C-2 was past 5 days from its first expense incurred in support of the ballot measure. It is quite possible and highly likely that Montana Women Vote incurred expenses in support of the ballot issue prior to

February 1, 2010. This failure to timely file the C-2 is a violation of Montana's campaign finance laws.

By engaging in political activity, complainant believes that Montana Women Vote may be acting outside the course and scope of its nonprofit organization status as allowed under the IRS rules and guidelines regarding political activities of nonprofit organizations.
